WE HAVE UPDATED OUR PRIVACY POLICY

On May 25th 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR) will come into effect. Our privacy policy has been updated to reflect these changes.

KEY CHANGES:

GDPR contains the following protections regarding personal data:

- Right to access the personal information a company holds on you.
- Right to have your personal information communicated to yourself or a third-party.
- Right to have any errors of your personal information corrected.
- Right to contest, particularly in relation to direct marketing.
- Right to restrict processing of your personal information.
- Right to have your personal information deleted on request.

Your Data:

As a valued customer, you can be confident that we take data protection very seriously, and we only use your personal information to provide our services to you. Personal Data we collect is typically sourced from the following format:

- Information that you have provided to us via telephone, email, post.
- Information received through the contact form on our website.
- Information collected via Cookies. Cookies are small files that enables the site of a service providers' system to recognise your browser and capture and retain certain information. We use these Cookies to compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interaction to help us offer a better service to our customers.

Third Parties:

We do not sell, trade or otherwise transfer, your personal data to third parties. However, this does not include trusted third parties who we use to assist us in operating our website, conducting our business or providing our services to you. Occasionally on our website, we include or offer third party products/services. These third party sites have their own independent privacy policies. We therefore have no responsibility for the content or activities of these linked sites. Nonetheless, we seek to protect the integrity of our website and welcome any feedback about these sites.

Data Security:

Security of personal data we hold is extremely important to us. We take appropriate measures to protect this data. At our disposal are a range of technologies and processes to provide data security and we actively monitor emerging cyber threats on a daily-basis.
